DEAR CITIZENS OF STRASSEN,

It's already been a year since the local elections. The CSV party achieved an excellent result and now has 5 members on the 15-member Strassen municipal council.

We have a lot of work ahead of us, and we want to implement an ambitious coalition programme over the next 6 years. In this context, it is important for us, as a multicultural municipality, to take care of everyone.

Strassen is growing and our infrastructure must grow with the municipality. That's why we're planning a new school for our children, with an integrated maison relais.

Between the school and 'Les Thermes' is an area dedicated to our youth activities. A new youth centre will be built between the new skateboard track, the beach volleyball courts and the multi-sports pitch. Here, our young people will be able to organise events and carry out a variety of activities.

Strassen has a well-functioning community life. Our sports clubs have very good results, both in terms of adult performances and, above all, in their work with young people. This is why the municipality supports them as much as possible. We have started building new football pitches and are currently planning a new sports hall.

Another major project in the pipeline is the construction of an integrated centre for the elderly next to our senior citizens' residence at Park Riedgen. 50 rooms will be built there over the next few years. Citizen participation is very important to us. When we were planning our new village centre, many people attended our workshops and were able to contribute their ideas. Many citizens also volunteered to work on the various advisory commissions of the municipality. We take this cooperation very seriously. Not all suggestions can be taken on board, but it is important that they are all recorded and discussed so that they can then be evaluated and potentially incorporated into our planning.

STROOSSEN

Housing remains a major problem. Our young and not so young people, whether single or with families, can hardly afford accommodation in Strassen any more. Thanks to the purchase of affordable housing, we have the opportunity to enable them to rent or buy via leasehold a home in Strassen. A municipal housing department will now be responsible for implementing these projects.

Road and noise pollution is high in Strassen. As you can see from the press, we are constantly working to improve the situation. We want the tramway to be extended to Belle Etoile, and not just to the CHL.

In life, however, it's not enough to plan and build, you also have to make time for leisure and culture. That's why we'll be continuing to organise concerts, our Stroossefestival and major exhibitions, so that we can all have a good time together.

COMMISSIONS CONSULTATIVES

The advisory commissions allow the citizens of Strassen to discuss various topics and to issue opinions to the college of aldermen. The CSV also has members who participate in these commissions, and we will now introduce them. Since this legislature, the committees have been open for all citizens of Strassen, as provided for in the coalition agreement.
