## REALIZATION OF THE COALITION AGREEMENT FOR THE CITIZENS OF STRASSEN

It has already been 2.5 years since the last communal elections, meaning 2.5 years during which we, together with the LSAP and déi Gréng, have set about implementing our coalition agreement in the interest of the citizens of Strassen. And indeed, in these 2.5 years, a lot has already happened in all the thematic areas of the coalition agreement:

### FAMILY, SCHOOLS, CHILDCARE AND MAISON RELAIS

- Improvement of school transport: Precoce students (early learners) are now also transported by bus, creation of a „Pedibus“ (walking bus) for the Cité Pescher, designation of safe school routes, and transport to the Karate hall.
- Environmentally friendly transport: School buses are being converted to electric power.
- There is better cooperation between the school and the Maison Relais.
- Local Family Meeting Point (LOFT): A contact point for parents and children for orientation assistance, and a place where families can meet.

- Information evenings are regularly organized to advise parents and young people.

### YOUTH

- The large skatepark is completed and is supervised by two professional skate monitors.
- The Youth Centre now has a street worker, who offers psychological and social support.
- A new, modern Youth Centre will open in 2026 near the skatepark.
- Many holiday jobs for students and babysitter training courses are offered.

### SENIORS

- The plans for a CIPA (Centre Intégré pour Personnes Âgées) with 50 beds next to the current Résidence Riedgen are developed.
- The Communal Senior Plan is now being implemented, with the help of the Third Age Commission and the Club Activ Plus.
- Services: New older citizens receive dedicated information and our website, featuring the offer for seniors, has been updated.
- Training: Training courses are offered for seniors, especially in the context of digitization.



## **PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY AND CITIZEN-CENTRIC ADMINISTRATION**

- Citizen participation: Citizen meetings are systematically organized to discuss neighborhood developments (e.g., parking rue des Capucines in the Pescher district).
- The Participatory Budget has been introduced, and four projects (cookbook, mini-golf, walking path, photovoltaics on the Hueflach shelter) will be implemented by mid-2026. The next cycle will be launched at the end of 2026.
- Transparency: The doors of the College of Aldermen are always open, and information from the Communal Council debates is quickly made available in three languages. In the future, the Communal Council will be made even more accessible.
- Most communal commissions are now also open to non-partisan citizens.

## **INTEGRATION AND INCLUSION IN OUR MUNICIPALITY**

- Integration: A „Welcome to Strassen – the municipality introduces itself“ evening is organized every two years.
- Multicultural events: Regular events to bring all citizens together (e.g., Marche gourmande, White Dinner, ...).
- Disability: Elaboration of the „Communal Disability Plan“ with experts and a systematic effort to make Strassen barrier-free (planning for an inclusive playground near the Children’s Clinic).

## **SOCIAL POLICY**

- Social assistance: A competent Social Office and the foundation of the „Stuff“ in House 48 to support women.
- Work integration: Further expansion of the PINSS (Projet d’insertion social Strassen) project for re-integration into society and work.
- Financial aid for socially weaker citizens (Allocation de vie chère, rental subsidy, ...).
- Creation of a Housing Service to help people apply for housing subsidies and manage communal properties.
- Service of a Mediator to mediate in neighborhood disputes.

## **VOLUNTEERING AND ASSOCIATION LIFE**

- Volunteering: Creation of the local platform „volunteer.lu“ to bring associations and citizens together.
- Signing of a sustainability charter with the associations to promote sustainability at events.
- Hiring of a Sports Coordinator to ensure the coordination of sports activities and to be the first point of contact for sports clubs.
- Maximum financial and material support for the associations, especially for youth work.

## **SPORT**

- Leisure Sports: Expansion of the offer, including for people who work during the day (evening courses)

- and introduction of the successful „Fit duerch de Summer“ (Fit through the Summer) program.
- Infrastructure: Planning for an enlargement of the sports hall and completion of the new football complex.

## CULTURE

- Events: Strassen Festival, celebration for the 175th birthday, with exhibitions and a retro fair. A large Art Biennale will be organized again in 2026.
- Promotion of young talent: „Art Week“ by the Maison Relais. Creation of an „Espace Culture“ in the new Youth Centre for young talents.
- Historical heritage: Hiring of historians to establish an archive and document the cultural and historical heritage of Strassen.



## VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT, HOUSING AND URBAN PLANNING

- Alternative forms of housing: Installation of the first Tiny House, more to follow.
- New residential areas: Planning with intelligent densification, optimization of land use, minimization of sealing (paving), and maximization of biodiversity. In addition, integration of modern traffic concepts.
- The new Communal Hall (wooden structure) and new communal buildings are being constructed with sustainable materials.
- Public facilities: Installation of public drinking water dispensers.
- Redesign of the village center in collaboration with citizens, with beautification of the square in front of the town hall and the installation of shops/restaurants (e.g., ViTo's).

## ENVIRONMENT, ENERGY, AND CLIMATE PROTECTION

- Structures: Well-functioning Climate and Nature Pact team. A new Energy Commission is working on optimizing energy sources.
- Renewable energy: Consistent expansion of photovoltaics on communal roofs and over parking lots (e.g., at the new football pitch).
- Lighting: Systematic conversion of public lighting to LED to save electricity and minimize light pollution.
- Waste and Recycling: New waste regulations with maximum promotion of sorting. Installation of sorting bins in public spaces. Promotion of „Anti-Waste“ in the school canteen and at events. Introduction of a repair bonus.
- Awareness: Systematic sensitization about climate

change and resource management in schools.

- Green spaces: Creation of walking paths on the construction waste dump and planting of trees along the streets, where possible.

## MOBILITY AND PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- For a better quality of life, we demand the following from the Ministries:
  - Speed limit of 90 km/h on the motorway in Strassen.
  - Effective noise protection (whisper asphalt and sound barriers).
  - Covering the motorway 300m before the Arelerstross and 300m after the Kiem.
  - Extension of the tram via the Arelerstross up to Mamer.
- Cycle paths and Speed: Expansion of the cycle path network and introduction of a „cycle street“ in the Rue de Romains. Limitation of speed in all residential areas to 30 km/h.
- Alternative mobility: Expansion of the FLEX Car-Sharing system (new locations) and installation of new electric charging stations in residential areas.
- Danger points: The traffic commission has identified danger points, which are now being addressed gradually.
- Bus@Strassen: Merger with Bertrange's Berti; four buses transport people to all destinations in both municipalities.

## LIVING SAFELY AND HEALTHILY IN OUR MUNICIPALITY

- Safety: The local police has been strengthened (more available and visible), and the municipality publishes information on current security issues.
- Health: Regular first aid courses and courses on mental health. Themed days to raise citizen awareness about risks and prevention.

## LOCAL ECONOMY

- Circular Economy: Creation of the platforms „Gutt Geschier“ (tool lending) and „Give Box“ (exchange of everyday items) at the ‚A Schmatts‘ farm. Regular organization of the ‚Repair Café‘.
- Bureaucracy: Abolition of low-yield taxes to avoid unnecessary bureaucracy.
- Visibility: Conducting a study to record all busines-

ses in Strassen; the goal is to give these companies more visibility.

A large part of the points of the coalition program have therefore already been implemented or are in the process of being implemented. We will continue our work with great motivation over the next 3.5 years.
